

## PREVENTION AND CONTROL OF COVID-19 ACROSS SLOVAKIA'S MARGINALISED ROMA COMMUNITIES

**Summary of the impact:** Andrej Belak's continuous expert engagement in the state management of the COVID-19 pandemic across the country's marginalised Roma communities enabled gradual adoption of a more effective and sensitive approach to the pandemic spread and impacts (both health and social) across the social settings, increased local general awareness of the Roma vs non-Roma health inequity and its key (social) determinants, as well as promotion of the utility of critically applied and collaborative medical anthropology.



**Underpinning research:** Previous long-term medical anthropological research focusing on the social determinants of the extremely poor health status of Slovakia's marginalized Roma.

- Development of an MRCs-dedicated COVID-19 epidemiological surveillance system
- Consultations for the central state pandemic crisis management bodies
- Setup of and leadership in the Slovak Ministry of Health's MRCs-dedicated panel on the pandemic
- Participation in selected control and prevention interventions across MRCs
- Continuous monitoring of the pandemic spread into and within the MRCs (identification of epidemic hot-spots and infection trends)
- Continuous monitoring of the pandemic health- and social impacts across the MRCs (via >10 indicators, including for testing, quarantines, hospitalisations, and deaths)
- Continuous monitoring of the vaccination against COVID-19 across the MRCs
- Effective and sensitive targeting and tailoring of COVID-19 prevention and control campaigns and interventions; personal participation in selected intervention pilots within MRCs
- Identification of a new SARS-CoV-2 variant breakthrough into and spread across Slovakia
- Continuous monitoring of and evidence on the unequal approaches to and impacts of the pandemic across the MRCs, compared to in the general population
- The White Crow civil society award to Andrej Belák for the engagement
