QUALITATIVE MODULE

- initial mapping of church based religiosity (online questionary + in situ interviews)
- multi-levelled + multi-sited ethnographies
 (15 localities = 300 interviews + 300 photographs, videos)

DESIGN



- QUANTITATIVE perspective at national context (SPSS)
 - QUALITATIVE perspective:
 - (1) multi-sited ethnography, stationary and return research; (2) multivocal ethnography: multi-levelled perspective and local embeddedness—whole spectrum of target groups, including the comparative Non-Roma sample
 - multidisciplinary approach





METHODS – analysis

- content analysis (Schrier 2014; Herzog, Handke, Hitters 2019)
- thematic analysis (e.g., Boyatzis 1998)
- interpretative-phenomenological analysis (Smith et al., 2009)






WORKING ASSUMPTIONS

- religious and spiritual seekers as well as indifferent, unbelieving, non-practicing, atheists or quite secular people are also significantly represented in the Roma communities.









Roma Pilgrimage, Gaboltov, 2023









PRELIMINARY RESULTS

- QUANTITATIVE MODULE: there is no "ethnic" pattern of religiosity, spirituality or non-religiosity;
- MAPPING: some faith-based organisation follow the model "sect-to church", and some "church-to-sect" or "sect-to-cult"
