# Family and faith...

- religion as "family" issue
- One of the functions of the family is religious functions (Mitterauer, Seder 1982)
  - religious socialization
  - commitment to the faith of family, kinship, and community
- V. Bengtson (2013) for the successful transmission highlights parental warmth, role of grandparents

# Family and faith


 3 types of nontransmission – religious rebels, zealots and prodigals (188)

 According to the 2021 Census, 60.7 % of Romani people are Roman Catholics and 17 % are nones (the population of Slovakia – 55.8 % Roman Catholics, 23.8 % nones)

# Family and faith...

- homogamy decreases the salience of cultural distinctions in future generations and that individuals marrying a spouse of a different denomination may lose negative attitudes toward that group, thus, possibly interconnecting the social networks of both partners (Kalmijn 1998)
- shared views on fertility aspirations, family size, marital stability
- Preference of marrying within the community (response to ethnic segregation, and a cultural choice with social and economic advantages (Gamella 2005)

### Faith and families





- 88 % of Romani couples are religiously homogamous, 14,9 live in cohabitations
- 73,8 % of the couples in Slovakia is religiously homogamous

## The "none" Romani couples

- There is around 1.578 homogamous non-affiliated Romani couples (10 % of all homogamous Romani couples) (around ¼ are cohabiting partners)
- 1.380 couples compound nuclear families
  - with 4000 children, of which 82 % are nones and 8 % are Roman Catholics
  - 33 % of them live in Southern Central Slovakia, 55 % in Eastern Slovakia
  - 74% of males and 79.7 % accomplished only elementary school
